

The Spasticity Clinic at the Perron Institute is run by Movement Disorder specialists with a Senior Physiotherapist in attendance.

To refer a patient to the Spasticity Clinic both of the following are required:

1. A Medical referral form completed by their GP or treating specialist.
2. A referral from a patient's treating therapist.
3. Ongoing therapy or a therapy program in place following injections.

Referrals need to identify the goal(s) of current treatment and toxin intervention. The primary aims are usually focussed on an improvement in either:

- 1) Function/mobility; 2) Positioning; 3) Pain; or 4) Hygiene.

A description of the relevant muscles and how spasticity is preventing your patient achieving these is helpful, including any relevant outcome measures.
